

UNDER 13 CUP RULES

Title

The title of the Competition shall be the ECB Under 13 National Club Championship for the Ken Barrington Cup.

Please refer to ECB website for full rules (except below)

Qualification of Players

A player may represent the club in the Competition if they are Under 13 years of age at midnight on 31st August prior to the season of the Competition. All players must be bona-fide Junior Members of the club they represent. A player may only play for one club in the competition in any one season.

Playing Conditions

1. The Laws of Cricket shall apply with the following exceptions / amendments.

In all matches:

- i. The pitch shall be 21 yards in length.
 - ii. The ball shall weigh $4\frac{3}{4}$ ozs.
 - iii. The stumps shall be 27 ins. above the ground and 8 ins. wide. (see Law 8.4)
 - iv. Each innings shall be a maximum of 20 overs in duration. A minimum of 10 overs per side will constitute a match. If the number of overs available to each side are not equal then run rate will be used to decide matches.
 - v. No bowler shall bowl more than 4 overs in a match. In matches of less than 20 overs a side the number of overs per bowler will be reduced pro rata.
 - vi. No fielder except the wicket, shall be allowed to field nearer than 11 yards, measured from the middle of the stump, except behind the wicket on the OFF SIDE.
 - vii. When a batsman reaches or passes the personal total of 30 runs they must retire and will not be allowed to return. A batsman can continue their innings beyond 30 if their retirement would end the innings before the agreed number of overs have been bowled.
 - viii. The team scoring the most runs shall be the winner.
 - ix. Junior Fielding restrictions
Please refer to generic Playing condition 5.
 - x. Law 40.2—Wicket keeping gloves
Please refer to generic Playing condition 8.
 - xi. In the event of the scores being equal the winner shall be determined as follows:
 - a. The team which has taken a greater number of wickets
 - b. If still equal the side with the highest score at the end of 19 overs, if still equal, 18 overs etc
 - c. Bowl out.
4. In the event of a rain curtailed match
- i. The match must be replayed on the reserve date.
 - ii. If weather curtails the reserve date, the winner shall be decided by a bowl-out
 - iii. Or, if a bowl out is not possible the winner shall be decided by the toss of a coin.
 - iv. Please note the fixed dates for the first two rounds after that, please ensure that games are completed by the play by dates as we have to inform the ECB of the Warwickshire winners by the 6th July. If teams fail to comply, we may have no option but to eliminate them from the competition.
